Filing an Official Program of Study & Advancement to Candidacy Master of Public Administration and Master of Arts in Latin American Studies

Advancement to Candidacy

All students must meet the general requirements for advancement to candidacy as described in Part Four of this bulletin and be recommended by the graduate advisers of both programs. In addition, all students must (1) complete Public Administration 600 and three additional courses selected from Public Administration 604, 605 or 606, 630, 642, 650, 660; (2) complete Latin American Studies 600 and 601; (3) achieve a grade point average of 3.0 in these course with no grade below B-; (4) complete with a grade of B (3.0) or better, Spanish 302 or Portuguese 401, or their equivalents, or three units of 500-level or graduate coursework in Spanish, or pass the American Council of the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) oral proficiency examination in either Spanish or Portuguese with a score of 2.0 or above; (5) demonstrate international experience in Latin America through an approved study abroad or an international internship experience, or successful completion of Latin American Studies 550, an approved study abroad experience course.

The first step in Advance to Candidacy is submitting your Official Program of Study (OPS)

- Students are eligible to submit an *Official Program of Study* (hereafter referred to as *OPS*) after completing PA 600 and at least three other required courses. Also required is a GPA of at least 3.00, and Classified Graduate Standing.
- The *OPS* should be submitted **NO LATER** than the semester prior to anticipated graduation and prior to signing-up for comprehensive exams or thesis.
- The MPA/MA LATAM program consists of 54 units with an additional 3 to 12 units of internship, if not waived.
- Students are to complete PA 796, which is a 12-unit internship requirement. However, this course may be waived completely or partially after submitting the Internship Waiver Request Form can be found in PSFA 100 or at http://spa.sdsu.edu/forms/MPA_INTERNSHIP_WAIVER_REQUEST_FORM2016.pdf

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Additional information for filing an OPS

Students should consult the current **Graduate Bulletin** for more information about the policies and procedures to be followed in completing and filing the Official Program of Study (OPS).

Do not include any core course in which the student received a grade of B- or lower, nor an additional course in which the student received a grade of C- or lower. Do not include any course with a WU (withdrawal unauthorized), or INC (incomplete authorized). Additionally, no course completed more than seven years prior to submission may be included on a program of study.
